

Privacy Policy

This privacy statement explains the reason for the processing, the way FLORINT collects, handles and ensures protection of all personal data provided, how that information is used and what rights you may exercise in relation to your data (e.g. the right to access, rectify, or block your personal data).

FLORINT is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy.

1. Why do we process your data?

FLORINT will process any personal data it receives in the context of its professional relationship with any third party in full compliance with EU and Dutch applicable legislation such as the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) (Regulation (EU) 2016/79).

FLORINT will only collect personal data which is strictly necessary to achieve the purpose for which the personal data have been collected.

FLORINT will not keep personal data any longer as needed for achieving the purposes for which the personal data have been collected or obtained, except if it's obliged to do so by law and/or professional rules of conduct.

2. Which data do we collect and process?

The personal data collected and processed are potentially:

- Name and surname;
- Organisation name and country;
- Company address and invoice data;
- E-mail address and telephone number;
- Date of birth, nationality, and postal address.

3. How long do we keep your data?

FLORINT only keeps the data for the time necessary to fulfil the purpose of collection or further processing. Personal data are kept as long as follow-up actions to the meeting are necessary with regards to the purpose(s) of the processing of personal data as well as for the meeting and its related management.

If data subjects do not agree with this, they may contact the Data Controller(s) by using the contact information as mentioned below at point 7.



4. How do we protect your data?

FLORINT uses up-to-date IT procedures to keep personal data safe and secure. All data in electronic format (emails, documents, uploaded batches of data etc.) are stored on the servers of contractors. Those contractors are GDPR compliant and bound with by a specific contractual clauses and privacy policy provisions for any processing operations of your data.

5. Who has access to your data and to whom is it disclosed?

- a. In the context of communications and meetings organized by FLORINT, your data is accessible to:
- FLORINT's staff; President, Board Members, and Members
- b. In case of litigation your data may be accessible to:
- IDOC, OLAF, EDPS, Court of Auditors on a case-by-case base.

6. What are your rights and how can you exercise them?

You are entitled to access your personal data and rectify and/or block it in case the data is inaccurate or incomplete. You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. You can exercise your rights by contacting the data controller(s), and if necessary the European Data Protection Supervisor using the contact information given at point 7 below.
